



**NORTH EAST DOC - A COMMUNITY SERVICE**

# PROVIDING CONTINUITY OF CARE OUTSIDE NORMAL SURGERY HOURS

- The North East Doctor-On-Call service provides you and your family with an experienced local family doctor outside normal surgery hours: between 6pm and 8am Monday to Friday and 24 hours a day during weekends and bank holidays.
- The service was established in September 2000.
- North East DOC (Doctor-On-Call) is a partnership between the North Eastern Health Board and General Practitioners in the North East region.
- The service is provided through a single call-save telephone number.



#### WHEN AND HOW TO MAKE CONTACT

When you need to contact a GP outside normal surgery hours:

#### **CALLSAVE 1850 777 911.**

North East Doctor-On-Call, although not a replacement for the emergency services, diverts unnecessary visits from the Accident & Emergency units to the after-hours GP service.



# WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU MAKE CONTACT

When you call 1850 777 911, your call will be answered by specially trained personnel who will ask you the following questions:

- Name, address and date of birth
- Telephone number
- Symptoms of illness/complaint
- Name of your own GP
- Medical card details (if applicable)

This information will be given to the doctor who will return your call promptly.

#### CONSULTATION WITH THE DOCTOR

In consultation with you, the doctor on call will advise on the most appropriate course of action, for example:

- Immediate medical advice over the telephone
- A visit to a treatment centre for further examination and treatment by an experienced family doctor.
- Where the need is determined, the doctor will visit the patient in their own home.
- Where a home visit is necessary, the doctors on call are supported by a fleet of specially equipped vehicles, with experienced drivers.

## ON ARRIVAL AT THE TREATMENT CENTRE



Each centre is fully equipped to meet the needs of patients and is staffed with experienced local family doctors, nurses and receptionists.

- Your arrival will be expected.
- Your details will be checked.
- The doctor will see you quickly.

## YOUR OWN GP IS KEPT INFORMED

Details of your consultation are automatically forwarded to your own doctor before surgery opens.

#### ACCESSING THE SERVICE
